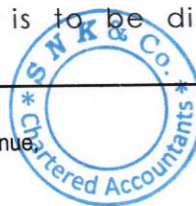

1. We have reviewed the accompanying statement of Unaudited Standalone financial results of Padmanabh Alloys & Polymers Limited for the Quarter ended June 30, 2026 (the "Statement") attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended.
2. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by the Board of Directors in their meeting held on August 14, 2026 has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 as amended read with relevant rules issued there under and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to issue a report on these financial results based on our review.

We conducted our review in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410, Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity issued by the institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the Statement is free of material misstatement. A review is limited primarily to inquiries of company personnel and analytical procedures applied to financial data and thus provides less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Notes:-

- 1 The Unaudited Financial Results of the Company for the quarter ended June 30, 2026 ("UFR") have been prepared in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standards notified under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, as amended and read with relevant rules thereunder. In terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) 2015, this Statement of UFR of the Company has been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their respective meeting held on **August 13, 2026**.
- 2 The company is primarily engaged in only one business of filled and reinforced Rermoplastic compounds and masterbatches and hence segment reporting is not applicable.
- 3 The figures for the quarter ended March 31, 2026 as reported in these results are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of the year ended March 31, 2026 and the published year to date figures upto the end of the third quarter of the relevant financial year. Also, the figures up to the end of the third quarter had only been reviewed and not subjected to audit.
- 4 The Earning Per Share(EPS) gas been computed in accordance with the Accounting Standards Earning Per Share(AS-20).
- 5 The previous year numbers have been regrouped/rearranged wherever necessary to conform to the current year presentation.The impact of such reclassification/ regrouping is not material to the financial statements.
- 6 Company has made provision for Gratuity of additional employees, in this quarter which includes directors and Key Managerial persons. The amount of provision of gratuity of Rs. 18.64 lacs made in this quarter pertains to additional provision for additional employees of the company.
